Dear Long Lake Property Owners:

The Long Lake Improvement District (LLID) has contracted to treat Curly leaf Pondweed in Long Lake in 2018.

The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources has granted to the LLID a waiver of the requirement that the District obtain the signatures of approval of owners of lakeshore property. Instead, the LLID will notify property owners of the treatment through alternate form[s]. This letter is one form that the LLID is using to notify property owners. Other forms [may] include notification on the LLID's web page www.llid.us, in the LLIA monthly newsletter and during the LLID's monthly meetings. The monthly meetings are scheduled for the 3rd Wednesday of each month at 6:30pm, at the Bradford Township Hall.

With regard to the treatment for this year, 2018:

The proposed date for treatment: April to early May 2018 (May be earlier: approximately 2 weeks after ice-out).

The target species for the treatment: Curly leaf Pondweed

The method of control or product being used: Under water injection of Aquathol K herbicide on invasive plants.

How landowners may request that control not occur adjacent to the landowner's property: If you desire that the treatment of Curly leaf Pondweed does **not** occur adjacent to your property, please notify the LLID, immediately at the following address, or email address:
